

The Aggregates project for the Institute of Human Health.

Financed by the Institute for Human Health Health Connect Fund, it focuses on building an infrastructure with the United States' research-based health care system. It will focus on the development of a Health Research-Integrated Research Health Care Infrastructure, including three research centers that will be the main focus of the project.

The goal of these activities was to demonstrate the benefits of the U.S. and European research [Health Research-Integrated Health Care Infrastructure](#) with specific goals around data science and infrastructure. The first round of activities was conducted in three main locations in Chicago: Chicago, Maryland, and Illinois. These activities will provide for an integrated research-based infrastructure. It will focus on data science and infrastructure.



The activities were delivered in two parts. The first part focused on the knowledge and awareness of health, research and research health through the research-based health and its research-based infrastructure. A second round of activities was conducted. In the final part of the activity, the participants received a certificate of completion. It was provided to all the participants who completed the activity.
