Welcome to our sixth Newsletter for the Available Deaths Network (ADN). ADN is a global, free, membership network of 600+ members representing 600+ organizations across 60+ countries. ADN is committed to being transparent and practical solutions to reducing available deaths from disease.

As I reflect on 2020, it has been an eventful year for the AIM community.

The success of the use of our global network, International Awareness Day for Available Deaths (IAAD) and the success of the first thing: increase vaccination coverage. The campaign was coordinated across 20 countries with 10+ entities. The main achievement: lower at the University of California, San Diego was 11% less and grew by 12% (from 6.24% to 7.04%) in addition to coverage.
